

UNIVERSAL BITE-BLOCK™ #11170 PEDIATRIC

INSTRUCTIONS:

Use with E.T. Tape or Adhesive tape products

1. Secure the endotracheal tube per instructions or procedure.
2. With the BITE-BLOCK at a slight angle, slip the bottom portion of the device onto the endotracheal tube behind the tape.
3. Pull the BITE-BLOCK forward until it rests against the tape.
4. Rotate Bite Block to lateral position.
5. Insert the elongated tab of the cable tie tightly around the tape where it circumvents the tube.
6. After tube placement confirmation, cut off remaining cable tie.

CAUTION: If the cable tie is not used, the tab must be securely taped to the endotracheal tube.

NOTE: Periodically inspect the bite block to assure proper position and function of the device.

Universal Bite Block should be changed every three days for hygienic purposes.
